

BANSW Registration Categories

Boxer

Annual registration (expires 31st December)

This is a requirement for anyone who wishes to compete in NSW and Australia. Also in NSW all boxers need to be registered with the NSW Combat Sports Authority.

Non-Participant

Annual registration (expires 31st December)

This registration is designed for non-combatants who wish to take advantage of the insurance provided by Boxing Australia.

Official/Coach

All coaches participating in NSW must possess Boxing Australia's Level One Coaching accreditation. This accreditation requires a participant to attend a two-day course, hold a working with children check and a first aid certificate. This course is delivered by Boxing Australia and accreditation is issued by Boxing Australia. This qualification is valid for four years, after this time coaches are required to reaccredit through the "on-line" reaccreditation page that is found on the Boxing Australia website.

BANSW requires that accredited coaches only to coach in BANSW affiliated boxing clubs and pay a \$50 annual insurance fee that expires on the 31st of December.

Also, in NSW all coaches must register with the NSW Combat Sports Authority.

This means that to corner an amateur boxer in NSW a coach must hold both accreditations.

Official/Referee & Judge

Referees and/or Judges (R&J) are required to qualify through a training seminar and "on-the-job" assessments. There is no annual fee, but all R&J must attend an annual refresher seminar and keep a log of all activities.

Annual General Membership

Annual registration (expires 31st December)

To be a member of BANSW a person is required to apply in writing to the Board, where, according to the constitution the Board "must as soon as practicable" approve or deny their application.

Members have the right to vote at the Annual General Meeting.
